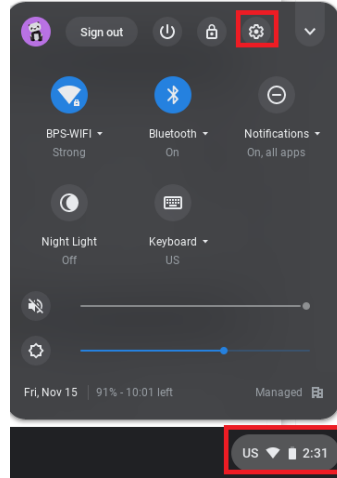


Chromebook - Accessibility Settings

Turn off (or on) Accessibility Settings:

- Click the System Tray
- Choose the Settings Gear



- Scroll down and click the arrow next to Advanced
- Scroll down to Accessibility
- Choose the arrow by Manage accessibility features

Always show accessibility options in the system menu ☐

Turn off the Toggle Menu Bar

- This what appears when Automatically click when the cursor stops is enabled

On Screen Keyboard

- This pops up when Enable on-screen keyboard is enabled

Keyboard and text input

Enable sticky keys (to perform keyboard shortcuts by typing them sequentially) ☐

Enable on-screen keyboard ☐

Enable dictation (speak to type)

Send your voice to Google to allow dictation into any text field. ☐

Highlight the object with keyboard focus when it changes ☐

Highlight the text caret when it appears or moves ☐

Open keyboard device settings

Allows you to adjust your keyboard repeat rate, word prediction, and more

Mouse and touchpad

Automatically click when the cursor stops ☐

Show large mouse cursor ☐

Highlight the mouse cursor when it's moving ☐

Open mouse and touchpad device settings
