Internship Description	Currently, each department within the agency maintains its own list of outside service providers who are important partners in helping our clients find the assistance they need. The intern will work to consolidate the lists to serve the whole agency and expand the list to include outside agencies that focus on specific cultural programming that reflects the diversity of our daily population. To accomplish this the intern will interview and interact with agency staff and clients to understand their needs and interests.

Schedule	Senior center is open 7 days a week- 8-4 M-F, 8-2 S-S. Food Bank is Monday- Friday, varying hours 9-5. Intern needs to be with staff and members during open hours, 5 hours per week
Working Location	Hybrid – in person at the agency 50% of required hours, remote the other 50%. Variable schedule accommodated but with weekly schedule posted in advance
