General Information:

- A. Application must be submitted in typed form.
- B. Completed application, including all required attachments, must be postmarked by June 1st and returned to:

- C. The scholarship of \$250 is non-renewable.
- D. Scholarship winner(s) will be announced at the awards ceremony held during the Summer at the 4-H Graduation.
- E. Scholarships will be disbursed during Second Semester of Freshman Year after the committee receives a copy of first semester grades as well as verification of second semester registration.

Eligibility Requirements:

- A. The applicant must be enrolled in a Chippewa County 4-H club during their senior year to be eligible to apply.
- B. The applicant must be registered in a shooting sports discipline during their senior year to be eligible to apply.
- C. The applicant's name must appear on all required pages of the application.
- D. The application form must be filled out completely and include required attachments to be reviewed for consideration.
