Arial font, size 9, justified. In terms of length, abstracts should be between 100 and 250 words.

Keywords: Indicate from three to five words for the retrieval of the text content. Separate them with a dot (.) Example: Vaccines. Measles. Temporary table. Arial font, size 9, justified.

(Resumo) Translate the abstract into Portuguese language.

Palavras-chave: Translate the keywords into the Portuguese language.

Arial font, size 12. Spacing: single with 6-point spacing afterwards, with the text arranged in a column. Alignment: justified. The citations must be according to the ABNT [NBR 10520](#) standard
