### Agendas/Planners

Please ensure your child brings their agenda to school every day. A parent must sign the agenda every night. Place any forms or notes into the front pouch of the agenda.

P.E.

Our P.E. classes are on Thursday and Friday. Please make sure your child wears their gym strip to school. Every item must be labeled.

On Fridays, when we have Mass, students must wear their full school uniform and only send in their runners for P.E.

## Homework/Nightly Reading

It is expected that students read each night Monday through Thursday for 15 minutes. Additional information will follow that will explain the home reading programs we partake in throughout the year.

Spelling and Math homework will be assigned on Mondays and returned on Thursdays. Spelling Tests will be on Fridays.

## Poetry Folders

Poetry folders are an exciting way for children to learn about different forms of literature and to read with expression. Each Friday, your child will bring home their poetry folder so they can share it with you. It is a fun activity for them, and will benefit with their reading fluency.. Please return the folder on Monday. A new poem or song will be added weekly.



# Star of the Day

Each student will have a few opportunities to be Star of the Day! On this special day, they bring in an object from home in a bag. They keep the item a secret and give the class 3 clues. Once the item has been guessed or if the 3 guesses are up, they get to share the object. The Star of the Day is also in charge of all the Calendar Activities, and they get to be the classroom leader, line leader, and helper for the day.
