INTRODUCTION

The content of the article is written in English. The introduction section presents at least three ideas: (1) background or rationale for the research, (3) problems and insights into the problem-solving plan, and the formulation of research objectives (and expectations about the benefits of the research results). For qualitative research, this section needs to present an explanation of the research focus and a description of the concepts related to the research focus.

Page margin size:

Right: 3cm, Left: 3cm; Top: 3cm, bottom: 2cm. Paper size: A4

Contents of the paper:

Times New Roman 11pt, Space 1. The title of the first sub-chapter is written in all capital letters and in bold (Bold), the title of the second sub-chapter is written in Capital at the beginning of every word except for conjunctions and in bold (Bold), the title of the third sub-chapter is written in Capital at the beginning words except conjunctions and bold italic (Bold Italic). Number of pages is 8-15. Right-left alignment (justified).

RESEARCH METHODS

This section includes a summary of the types of research, research subjects, data collection instruments, and data analysis techniques. For quantitative research, avoid writing statistical formulas excessively.

RESULTS AND IMPLEMENTATION

Papers written in Indonesia. Writing in the main description uses the font Times New Roman, size 11 pt, justified, 1 space, as in this document. Numbering starts with the numbers 1, 2, 3, etc. The paragraph format is justified, and in one page the top and bottom are aligned, so that the remaining spacing can be adjusted by the author.

Sub section

The title of the subsection is written in Times New Roman 11 pt, bold and written in the sentence case model (capital letters only at the beginning). Subsection titles are written without chapter numbers.

Page numbers, headers and footers

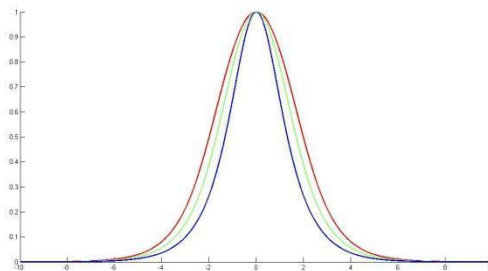
All submitted papers do not need to include page numbers and footers. This section will be added by the committee.

Figures dan Tables

Tables and figures are placed in the center of the page. Table titles are written above the table, while figure titles are below the figure, both in Times New Roman 10 pt font. The letters in the table use Times New Roman 10 pt, 1 space. The table uses only horizontal lines. Tables are depicted simply to avoid unsightly print results. Tables and figures are referred to in the paper. Tables and Figures are placed as close to the description that refers to the first time. Generally Tables and Figures are placed after being mentioned in the description of the paper. Numbering Tables and Figures are sorted from number 1 onwards. An example of a table can be seen in Table 1. Information on the figure should be brief, clear and represent the picture.

Equations are written using the Equation Editor or similar. Each variable in the equation is annotated the first time it appears. All equations are written in the center, with the serial number of the equation aligned to the right.

Example: the product moment correlation equation is:

$$r_{xy} = \frac{n\sum XY - (\sum X)(\sum Y)}{\sqrt{\{n\sum X^2 - (\sum X)^2\} \{n\sum Y^2 - (\sum Y)^2\}}} \quad (1)$$

References are written only those that are referred to in the paper and are written sequentially based on the initial letter according to the alphabet.
