

### 3 Achievements

The NICEST project started in January 2017. However the real work started after the F2F meeting in April 2017. In the 1st year we have struggled to make a distributed diverse team of eight different partners to work towards the common goal as written in the work plan. Some of the steps taken are

- Conducting regular team meetings: starting from September, 2017, regular online team meetings are held at fixed date and time slots
- Milestones are created for different deliverables
- Information sharing and communication: The NICEST wiki is regularly updated with all the meeting notes, status updates, milestones etc. Mailing lists are used for communication. Video conference for meetings etc.

With these steps, the team work in NICEST project is improving. Some of the achievements of the 1st year are submission of three deliverables, writing of the project plan, ESGF node administrator manual etc. which are described below.
