Note also, how the bibliography uses a “hanging indent.” If you don’t know how to set that up, the page below shows you how, in Microsoft Word. You might be able to figure out how to do it in Google docs by looking, on this page, at the ruler, above.

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*In Microsoft Word, to do a hanging indentation, as above, go to the paragraph menu. Under indent, go to “special” and choose “hanging” as shown on the next page.*
