Each community service result must be discussed. The discussion contains the meaning of the results and comparisons with theories and/or similar community service results. The length of the presentation of results and discussion is 40-60% of the total length of the article.

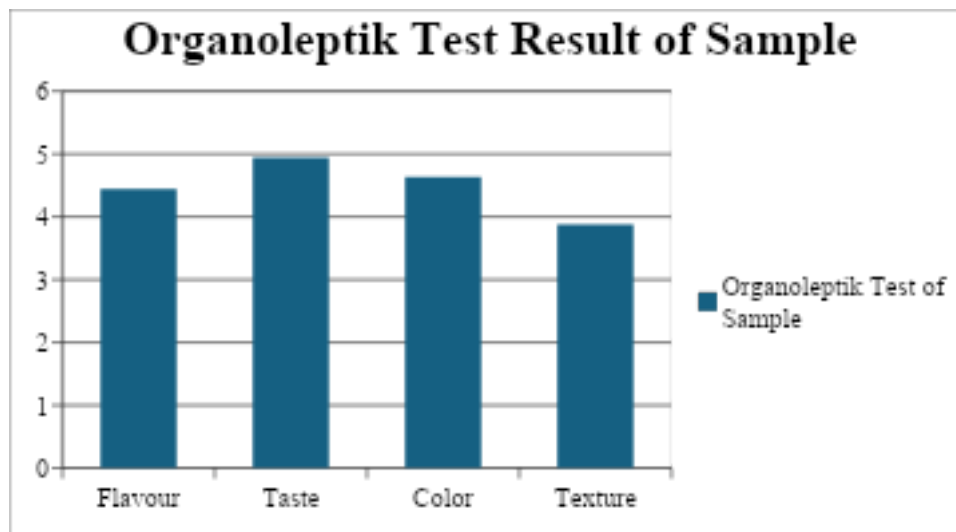


Figure 1. Caption
