Overview: The <u>Invention Bootcamp</u> is a four-week invention experience hosted at the Portland State University-College of Engineering and Computer Science by faculty and staff. High School students of all backgrounds and experience levels are encouraged to apply.

How Do I Apply?

You can submit the <u>Application in Spanish</u> or <u>Application in English</u>, depending on your preference.

The application is pretty basic but you do need to answer TWO free response questions:

- 1. Tell us about a time that you committed to something. What obstacles did you overcome? Did you complete your goal?
 - **Pro tip:** Talk about a job commitment, team project, or family responsibility that you've taken on/how you managed it.
- 2. Why do you want to participate in Invention Bootcamp?

You can choose the format for each of your responses. Your choices are:

- A. Short essay (250 words or less)
- B. Short video (2 minutes or less)
- C. Other creative response of a similar size

All application materials are due Friday, March 1st at 11:59 p.m.
