





A **Session Information** pop-up box will display the Session ID for the test.

Note: The session ID is simply a way to access the test. If the test expires before a student has had a chance to login, simply make a new access point by creating another session to the same test. The maximum time a session can remain open is 2 weeks.

Click Close.



Pause Rules

Students can pause a test at any time in order to temporarily log out of the test session. If a student pauses their test, they can resume their test using the same session ID:

- If the test is paused for less than 8 hours, the student can return to questions that were already answered and modify answers.
- If the test is paused for more than 8 hours, the student can return to questions that were already answered but cannot change the answers.
- All answers are saved immediately. They are not lost if the test is paused.

If the test session has ended, the test administrator will need to set up a new session, and the student must sign in to their test using a new session ID.

PASSAGES AND ALL ITEMS TIED TO A PASSAGE ARE CONSIDERED ONE QUESTION; THEREFORE, IF THE ALL ITEMS ARE NOT ANSWERED ON A PASSAGE AND STUDENT PAUSES FOR LONGER THAN 8 HOURS, THE PASSAGE WILL BE SCORED AS IS AND STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ANSWER THE REMAINING ITEMS TIED TO THE EXPOSED PASSAGE.

Students can pause the test at any time. Pausing the test logs out the student. To resume testing, students must repeat the sign-in process:

• To pause a test, students select **Pause** in the global menu and then select **Yes** in the confirmation message that appears.

If students are testing on Chromebooks, please ensure they pause the test before closing the lid of the Chromebook. If the lid closes before the test pauses, whoever opens the Chromebook next will be able to see the last question that the student viewed (and the response they entered.)

These pause rules apply regardless of whether the student pauses the test, or a technical issue logs the student out.

*A warning message displays after 5 minutes of inactivity and the student will be logged out after 20 minutes of inactivity.
