- Students may earn a National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC), a widely recognized credential that demonstrates essential workplace skills.
- Many employers use WorkKeys scores to identify candidates with the skills needed for specific positions.
- Results help students understand their strengths and align them with potential career paths.
- The school's overall WorkKeys performance is factored into the JHR's North Carolina school accountability grade.
