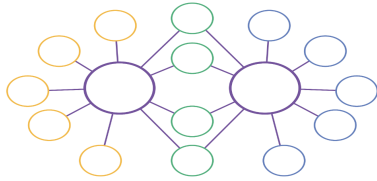

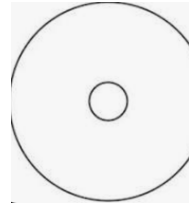
Choose ONE activity from EACH column for EACH remote learning day. Keep your work until we return to school and turn it into your teacher.

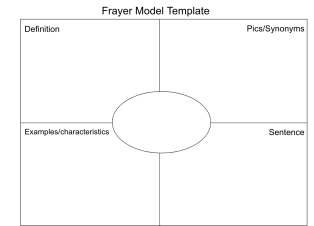
- ☐ Create a double bubble map **comparing** two characters from the story. Make sure to use evidence from the text.

- ☐ Choose 4 unknown words from the chapter(s) you read and create a circle map that shows context clues from the story to find the **meaning**.

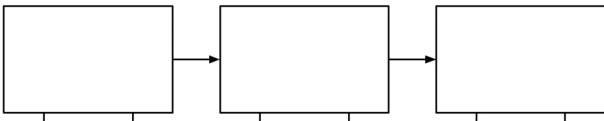


- ☐ Create a frayer model for a new vocabulary word from your book.

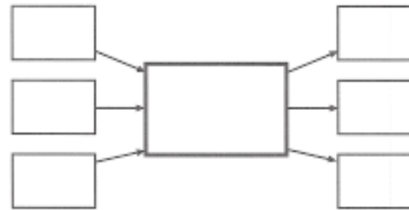

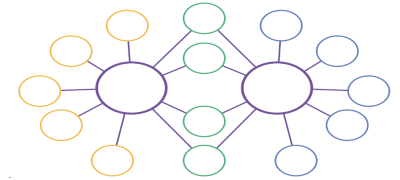
- ☐ Create a flow map to **sequence** the key events of the chapter(s) you read and then write a **summary**.



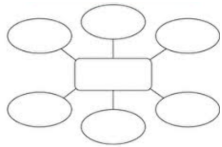
- ☐ Create a multi-flow map that shows a major event from the chapter(s) you read and the **causes** and **effects** of the event.
