SCPFA members are hereby notified that plans to resume past (pre-Covid Pandemic) eligibility criteria for the Walter B. Roberts Scholarship Competition will return with the 2028 competition. Specifically, 2028 competitors for the Walter B. Roberts Scholarship “must have auditioned in a previous SCPFA festival as a high school sophomore or junior” to be eligible to compete for the award. Additional comprehensive eligibility requirements for the Walter B. Roberts Scholarship remain the same as previous years and are outlined in SCPFA newsletters issued to active SCPFA members.
