Cheat Sheet to Moodle Quiz Preparation 1

This Cheat Sheet gives five basic steps explained in very simple terms on how to easily prepare a quiz of multiple choice type with any number of questions in a short time in the latest MOODLE LMS ver. 3.7.2

After entering the AU portal, on the left side click on the menu item LMS, then E-learning. You are in your LMS area. Click on the subject you want to administer the QUIZ. (for others, open MOODLE LMS on your desktop)

Step 1: PREPARING QUESTION BANK

Put all your objective type questions, as much as 20 -30, in the Aiken format as shown below into a simple text editor and save as a txt file.

Which is the capital city of india?

- A) Kolkata
- B) Pune
- C) Patna
- D) New Delhi

ANSWER: D

Jawaharlal Nehru was India's first Prime Minister.

A) TRUE

B) FALSE

ANSWER: A

(remember no question number, start from column 1, leave a line before the next question, follow the exact format given above, save as quiz1.txt or xxxx.txt in simple txt format in your computer)

Step 2: ADD ACTIVITY QUIZ

- a. Go to your subject area in the LMS.
- b. Enter edit mode and add the activity QUIZ.
- c. Edit QUIZ settings like *timings, duration, attempts, password, number of questions on each page*

Step 3: IMPORT QUESTIONS FROM QUESTION BANK INTO LMS DIRECTORY

- a. Click on **QUIZ** and click on the edit Wheel mode at top right ...
- b. Scroll down, look for Question Bank, Import.
- c. In the screen, click on AIKEN format, leave other settings as it is, and Save

Step 4: EDIT QUIZ BY ADDING QUESTIONS FROM QUESTION BANK

- a. Click on Quiz in top menu
- b. Click on Edit QUIZ button
- c. Click on *Add* hyper link
- d. Tickmark the questions you wish to add from the Question Bank
- e. Click on ADD button,

Step 5: PREVIEW QUIZ

- a. In EDIT mode, click on PREVIEW button
- b. Ask a student to check whether QUIZ is visible at E-learning site
- c. Inform students about the quiz duration, time window, password and ADMINISTER THE QUIZ
