

EXTRAORDINARY AWARD CRITERIA PhD IN NEUROSCIENCES

The Academic Committee of the Doctorate in Neurosciences program establishes that the assignment of Extraordinary Doctorate Awards must be based on the following criteria:

- a. Qualification obtained
- b. Quantity and quality of publications derived from the thesis in indexed journals. The journal's impact index, quartile and decile where it is located and the candidate being the first autor.
- c. Patents obtained from the thesis project.
- d. Thesis Mention for Compendium of Publications and/or for International Mention.

The current regulations, approved by the UAB Doctorate Committee, indicate that -at most- an extraordinary prize can be awarded for every 5 theses or fraction of the same academic year.

The Commission that awards the prizes can leave them deserted if it considers that the theses defended in this academic year do not reach the necessary quality.
