



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

With November 5th coming up, the District continues to connect with our residents to inform voters about the proposed referendum questions. We will be adding any common questions that we have been hearing from the community.

Where can I get more information about voting?

Visit the myvotewi.gov website to learn more about your voting options.

Wisconsin voters can receive their absentee ballot by mail. If you are a regular voter who would like to vote in the 2024 General Election, make sure to submit your request for an absentee ballot by October 31, 2024.

Vote early in your Municipal Clerk's office - Voters can request and vote an absentee ballot in-person in their municipal clerk's office beginning two weeks before Election Day and possibly through the Sunday prior to the election. **However, each municipality has different in-person voting hours so please contact your municipality directly to confirm your options.**
