CALIFORNIA

We adopt this section of this Notice to comply with the required “Notice at Collection” disclosures under California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (the “CCPA”), as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act of 2020 (the “CPRA”) (together, the “California Privacy Laws”).
