

Digital Flipbook Storytelling with Google Slides

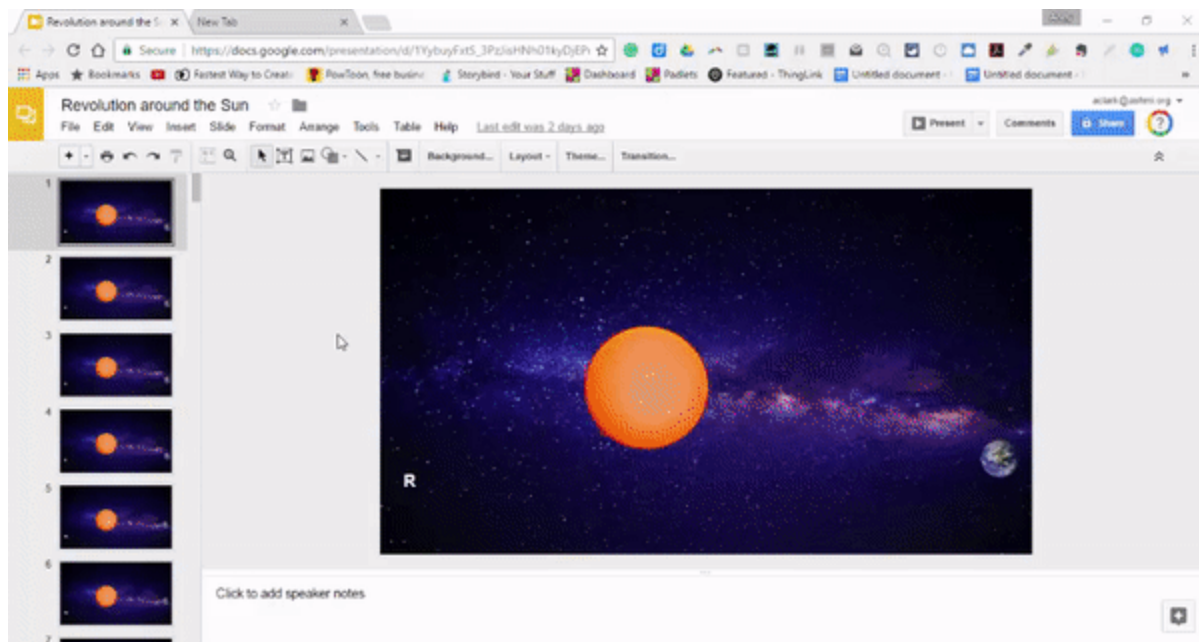
Remember making flipbooks as a kid? Paper flipbooks are a great way to create stop-motion style animation drawings. You can use Google Slides to easily construct animated digital flipbooks to tell a story that can be integrated into any content area. Find out how by signing up for this session.

Tips

- Map out a plan before you start (*Will you use text? If so, when will it come into the story? In which positions will the objects start? etc.*)
- Make small changes
- Duplicate each slide 1-4 times after the change depending on how fast you want the animation.
- Use transparent png images on the slides ([Free online image editor](#))
- To check progress on your flipbook, cycle through the slides using the down and up arrow keys.
- After publishing to the web, edit the URL by changing the number on the back end from **3000** to **250**. Copy the new link.
