



## Church Campus

### ***Actions that VPC has already taken to make our campus earth-friendly:***

**Energy-efficient lighting.** We've converted most lighting fixtures to LEDs and are in the process of converting remaining fixtures and exterior lighting.

**Renewable energy.** VPC gets electric power from Peninsula Clean Energy, the default electricity source for SMC residents and businesses. We've "opted up" to the PCE ECO100 service, which provides energy that is 100% carbon-free and 100% renewable. By default, SMC residents also get electric power from PCE via PG&E and are encouraged to check their PG&E billing statements to verify that the PCE Electric Generation Charges / Rate Schedule shows the ECO100 service.

**Recycling and Reuse.** VPC maintains recycle bins on campus. These could be upgraded to be more attractive to encourage their use. Office products are recycled where possible, and reuse / recycling is promoted for all campus events.

### ***Future earth-friendly campus actions include :***

**Water Bottle Filler -** installed a water bottle filling station to replace the water fountain.



**HVAC Systems -** Working to implement an energy-efficient (possibly heat pump) HVAC system for a building upgrade.
