

What is the Student Intervention Team?

The **Student Intervention Team (SIT)** is a team of educators in your school made up of a variety of perspectives to support individual students.

What does the Student Intervention Team do?

When classroom supports are not enough to ensure student success, students may be brought to the school SIT to determine additional academic and/or social emotional support based on student need.

The purpose of the SIT is to:

- Support teachers in reflecting on and enhancing their classroom and grade level practices and
- Support educators in providing interventions to meet students' academic and social emotional needs. t

Utilizing racial equity and social justice lens, the team considers the whole student when making decisions that affect their long-term educational experience and sense of belonging in PPS. SIT works to provide every student and adult what they need to thrive in the general education setting. **Caregivers are essential collaborators in identifying student strengths and needs and are included at all points in the process.**

What are example supports and interventions?

Area of Need	PPS schools use academic and social emotional information and data to inform what supports and interventions are provided. All interventions include monitoring a student's growth and progress towards successfully meeting their goals.
Academic	Academic Interventions include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Instruction that occurs for a length of time outside of core instruction time. Students do not miss core content.<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Elementary Example:<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students receive small group support during the What I Need (WIN block) at elementary level.■ Secondary Example:<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students receive support in an "advisory" model or intervention block, above support provided regularly for all students.
Social Emotional	Social Emotional Interventions may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Check-in/Check-out with a mentor○ Social Emotional Skills groups○ Breaks are Better○ Meaningful Work○ Behavior Support Plan based on a Functional Behavior Assessment (caregiver permission required for FBA)
