Step 1:	Attend Senior Fall Meeting (September-October)
	Sign up for an appointment with your School Counselor–check your August email for the link
	Complete GBE Senior Fall Survey in SchooLinks
	Attend Senior Fall Meeting appointment (reschedule, if needed)
	Review RAM Time presentation (Fall of Senior Year)
Step 2:	Apply to at Least 3 Post-Secondary Options (September-December)
	nvestigate multiple options based on your goals (college, <u>trades</u> , apprenticeships, <u>military</u>)
	Check 'To Do List' in SchooLinks and complete important action items
	Create application account on <u>Common App</u>
	Sign up for College Rep Visits at East in SchooLinks under School Events (schedule)
Step 3:	Using SchooLInks for College Applications
'	Watch <u>SchooLinks Video</u> on College Application Manager
	Update college favorites list in SchooLinks
	Update College Application Manager in <u>SchooLinks</u> - View <u>slide show</u> for step-by-step instructions
	Link SchooLinks & Common App accounts in SchooLinks College Application Manager

	Send <u>ACT/SAT</u> scores on your own, if needed (check with college)
Step 4:	Request Teacher Counselor Recommendations (<u>ONLY</u> if required)
_	Check in <u>SchooLinks</u> to see if a <i>teacher/counselor</i> letter of recommendation is required
	f required, request a teacher rec in-person or via email (2-3 weeks <u>prior</u> to deadline)
_	Update Profile/Resume under Students icon in SchooLinks if Teacher or Counselor Rec is required
	Invite your teacher via SchooLinks
Step 5:	Finances
	Create your <u>FSA ID Account</u> (student and parent) and gather <u>required documents</u>
	Complete the 2026-27 <u>FAFSA</u> beginning in October to satisfy graduation requirement and gather required documentsCreate Account Federal Student Aid
	☐ If not <u>eligible to complete</u> the FAFSA, fill out <u>Alternative App for Illinois Financial Aid</u>
	☐ If you are not planning on filing for financial aid, complete the <u>FAFSA Nonparticipation Form</u>
	Use the Net Price Calculator to get an estimate of the potential cost for each college
	Apply for scholarships through SchooLinks, including the GEHS Local Scholarship
Step 6:	Finalize Post-High School Plans (May 1st deadline)
	Complete the mandatory Post High School Survey in SchooLinks under April's 'To Do's'
	Schedule Senior Exit Meeting with School Counselor (April)
	Update your Enrollment Decision in SchooLinks to request Final Transcript
