Education related:

AB740 - Foster Youth suspension and expulsion - extends parental notification requirements to the attorney and social worker of a child in foster care.

SB532 - expanded access to diplomas for highly mobile youth (foster care, military, homeless, juvenile court pupil, migratory children, recent immigrants) - options for reduced graduation requirements or a 5th year of secondary school. Requirement to **consult** with pupil & ERH re: impact on further education, etc.

AB1686 - Child welfare agencies: enforcement - child welfare agencies are directed to presume child support is a barrier to reunification and not pursue parents for child support payments to the state on behalf of youth in foster care.
