## Things to look for when Evaluating a Presentation

**<u>Prepared</u>** Was the speech organized? Memorized or Read for paper?

**<u>Delivery</u>** Does the speaker seem relaxed and comfortable, confident? Nice posture?

**Nervous:** Does the speaker avoid meaningless filler words such as *uh* or *um*? Or fidget..?

**Voice-** Can you understand the speaker?

Dld they speak clearly for all to understand?

**<u>Vocal Variety</u>** do they use variations in the sound of their voice for expression? Or Monotone?

**Volume**: Is the speaker loud enough (but not too loud)?

<u>Pace</u> - Is the speaker's pace comfortable, not too fast or too slow?

**Enjoyable:** Does the speaker engage the audience and make it fun to watch/ listen?

**Eye contact**- Does the speaker make eye contact with others in the room?

**Content:** Is there a <u>clear purpose</u> or <u>theme</u> of the speech?

Did they use nice <u>vocabulary</u>? Transitional words? Use of Imagery/descriptive words?

Did the speaker show passion and knowledge of their topic?

<u>Use of visual aids: (optional)</u> Do the visual aids help you understand the speaker's message?

Are the visual aids well designed and free of distracting or confusing elements?

Does the speaker direct your attention to key points or visuals? Does the speaker adequately explain their significance?

## If it is a Persuasion speech...

Do you agree with the speaker? Did the presentation make you change your opinion? Why or why not?

Even if you disagree with the speaker, does the speaker adequately explain and defend his or her position?
