## Thomas Ford *Temperatures*

Yellow - Typical good student is having an OFF day.

**Behaviors include**: Head down, argumentative, isolating.

What to do: Encourage students to take a break, Encourage students to go to counseling, Keep an eye on them.

Orange\_- Struggling student is having a bad day.

**Behaviors include:** Excessive cursing, out of seat, hyperactivity, feet on desk, argumentative/aggressive posture.

**What to do:** (See Yellow) Email (Discreetly) ALL counselors to come grab the student from your class to avoid further escalation. Focus on them without being overtly on top of the student. Student may need to spend the day or remainder of the day in the counseling office.

**Red** - Student escalating to the point of a safety concern. Nonresponsive to any redirection, pacing aggressively around the room, refusal to see counseling or any interventions to this point.

What to do: Ask for support immediately.

Head out door: call for security and email ALL Counselors as well as Mrs. Kehm.

No student should know this system all emails and conversations should be kept between staff.
