885 COSMETOLOGY 2 Term: FY Grade 10 1.5 Credits Elective

Students continue their exploration of the world of Cosmetology through coursework and practical skills. Students must maintain good attendance in order to remain eligible for continuation in the program. The cosmetology curriculum is aligned to the required skills tested on the State Board licensing exam and for the Department of Health regulations governing Cosmetology programs. Students will gain a deeper understanding of key concepts such as sanitation, shampooing, hair styling, introduction to hair cutting, manicures, nail art and pedicures. Students receive instruction within a working salon, practicing skills through hands on application. Students can purchase a mannequin head and purchase an optional starter kit through the program. This course is a prerequisite to Cosmetology 2. Students who are interested in any aspect of the cosmetology field including theatrical makeup, barbering, and nail technician or a career in skin, nails, or hair should enroll in this program of study. Students may use the clinical hours in the salon as the required job shadowing hours for their graduation Googlio.
