Dyslexia endorsement, for licensed teachers, can be completed in one calendar year. This is an ADE-approved endorsement program and meets the standards of the International Dyslexia Association, the Arkansas Teaching Standards, and the International Literacy Association standards for Reading Professionals.

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The Arkansas Department of Education (ADE) requires successful completion of coursework which addresses all competencies of teachers for dyslexia, grades K-12 from an approved program of study. In addition, the ADE requires passing a current PLT Praxis exam. Expired versions will not be accepted by the ADE. If you are not teaching in Arkansas, check with your state department of education for specific requirements for licensure in dyslexia.
