What I Liked

I love the mystery of this series. I constantly found myself theorizing about what was going on, which was quite fun. I also love the sitcom elements of these episodes. That was a really different and fun idea that I really enjoyed. Also Jimmy Woo and Darcy are a great comedic duo and it's great watching them react to what's happening inside the hex from the outside. There are also some great elements that they did not have to include, but they did and it's amazing, the theme songs at the beginning of each episode are great, and I love the commercials halfway through each episode and how they each represent an important part of Wanda and her history and her sadness and depression.

What I Disliked

As great as this show is, it suffers a lot from the expectations of the fans. Because everyone was so convinced that this series would introduce Mephisto or Reed Richards or Mutants, it makes the ending that we actually got kind of disappointing. Also, everyone saw the Agatha all Along twist at the end of episode 7 coming. It really wasn't too surprising, which is disappointing considering it's supposed to be the biggest twist of the series. My biggest problem with this series is how Even Peters is only included to tease fans for a few episodes until the finale where he's simply used as a quick gag.

While this show can feel a bit anticlimactic due to what we were expecting, it's still a really unique and enjoyable installment to the MCU which is why it gets an **A-**.
