PSH is a program for people with disabilities and HIV. You can get a home plus utilities even if you don't have an income. It takes a while to qualify but you should start the process. If in DeKalb, call DeKalb Coordinated Entry - 404-687-3500 9-5 pm. If in Atlanta go through Partners For Home very early at Gateway in Atlanta or check out our Entry Point resource list for other places to start the process. Explain that you want PSH. Keep in mind you need a medical diagnosis of a disability. Ask your doctor for a HUD McKinney form documenting your disability.

People who believe they might have a mental health disability but have not been diagnosed can go to Grady Hospital, Mercy Care or Good Samaritan in Atlanta or Claratel in DeKalb to get treatment and a diagnosis.

Also try the places below to start the process of qualifying for Permanent Supportive Housing and to receive a Georgia Housing Voucher (GHVP).

P.A.T.H. If you have a mental health diagnosis. There's a few of these.
