

First-Year Bachelor of Architectural Studies Supply List (Semester One)

1. High-quality mouse (Used for: Rhino 3D, Grasshopper, and Adobe Illustrator)
2. Extendable Drafting Tube (to transport paper without sacrificing quality): Purchase **In Toronto** (due to large size)
3. **Mechanical Pencil** (critical for Freehand Drawing in ARC100)
4. Graphite Pencil (*for concept sketching in courses such as ARC100 and JAV130)
5. Portable Ruler (*Portable: A ruler that will not snap when travelling, such as a foldable ruler)..
 - a. Example 1: Midori Foldable Ruler (best choice for portability)
 - b. Example 2: Merangue Ruler (6''): Stainless Steel [Link](#)
6. Bond Paper / Cool White Paper (*To buy **in Toronto**) : [Link](#)
7. **Drawing Sketchbook** (ensure that the paper of your chosen sketchbook does not transfer or smudge too easily)!
8. Pins: To Purchase *in Toronto* (*Crucial for “Pin-Ups” and Critiques, particularly in Studio and Design Classes)
9. Portable Charger (for long nights in-studio)
10. Headphones

Essential Software:

1. **Rhino 3D** (Temporary Substitute: AutoCAD...) *Note: Rhino Comes with your Student License: Ensure to purchase it online via The Daniels Website / Your Daniel's Account
2. **Adobe Creative Cloud** : (All Apps)
 - a. Adobe Acrobat (Virtually required for utilizing any Post-Secondary documentation, in editing, exporting, and converting).
 - b. Adobe Illustrator (?)_Could this be substituted?
 - c. Photoshop (Optional, but prepares students for Semester no. 2)
 - d. Adobe InDesign (great and almost necessary tool for organizing presentable sheets or making portfolio)
