Levels: This is not a qualifier for 2026 USPC Champs.

This is a qualifier for the 2025 Mid-Atlantic Pony Clubs Rally Competition held in conjunction with the Virginia Horse Center Youth Equestrian Festival. Simply

completing the rally without elimination will enable you to compete at the $2025\ Festival$.

Starter Level – 2022 USEA Starter Test (small arena); jumps up to 2'3" for SJ and XC **Beginner Novice**—2022 USEF Beginner Novice Test A (small arena); jumps up to 2'7"; XC:

approx 1900m at 325 mpm. (Qualifying or Non-Qualifying)

Novice—2022 USEF Novice Test A (small arena); jumps up to 2'11"; XC: approx 2100m at

375 mpm. (Qualifying or Non-Qualifying)

Training--2022 USEF Training Test A (small arena); jumps up to 3'3"; XC: approx

2400m at 450 mpm. (Qualifying or Non-Qualifying)

Fees: Entry fee \$150 per VRPC Competitor. Fee includes stall, VHC Start Trial Entry fee, each

competitor must have one volunteer. No fee for Stable Managers.

Out-of-region competitor's fee is \$195 per rider. If parent volunteers at HT on Sunday \$25 refund will be processed.

Rally is being run in conjunction with VHC Starter Trial.
Competitors may move in on Saturday starting at 11:00AM (this is tentative). We will begin
HM turn out inspections on Sunday morning very early so everyone must move in on Saturday
and be rally ready by 6AM Sunday.
The XC Course will be open for walking with your coach at Saturday afternoon
The XC course is open for schooling through the VHC schooling day. Visit the VHC site for
more information and for instructions on how to register.
Competitors are required to wear their Medical Armband (containing their current USPC or
USEA Medical Card) or aMedical Bracelet for the duration of the rally.
Barn appropriate footwear is required at all times
Only the team captain or appointed designee may pick up registration packets.
Chaperones must be available on-site for the duration of the rally

Each competitor must have a volunteer available for Sunday.
