
Canvas at Lunch over Zoom

Spring Peer to Peer Recap



CANVAS END-OF-SEMESTER TIPS

Official Grades

Although you may track and update your student grades in the Canvas gradebook, you will still need to submit your final, official student grades to the University Registrar. Here is a quick guide explaining how to submit grades through the Faculty Self-Service area on your MYUSF page »

Final Canvas Gradebook Totals

The Total column in the gradebook will reflect the current scores of your students. Any assignment where you have NOT entered a grade (showing a dash) will be ignored in the final Total column calculation for that student. Also, any Muted assignments will be ignored in the student view of the gradebook. As a result, students will see a total grade which differs from your instructor view gradebook total. It is good practice to review your grades one last time.
