Representing Multiply within the region of the USMB Pacific District (PD) USA, the Regional Mobilizer fosters relationships with churches, mobilizes and trains disciples for mission, and strengthens partnerships with global workers and National Leaders.

Primary Job Functions/Essential Outcomes

1. Send North American Missionaries

- a. Build and steward relationships with pastors, mission leaders, and churches via regular phone calls, personal visits and monthly mobilization updates.
- b. Consult with Regional Team Leaders (RTL's) and missionaries for Long-term missionary (LTM) opportunities in their regions.
- Assist churches to identify and discern those called to LTM assignments; assist Multiply in the discernment process.
- d. Disciple potential missionaries along the pathway toward LTM deployment.
- e. Consult with existing long-term missionaries for deeper US partnerships and preparation for their MINA (Ministry in North America).
- f. Ensure timely thank you calls are completed and documented for the Region with a focus primarily on the church relationship.

2. Partner with National Leaders

- a. Connect churches to Regional Team Leaders, National Leaders, and missionaries to strengthen global partnerships.
- b. Facilitate partnership workshops and vision trips to create better partnerships with NLs that align with our core values.

3. Help Everyday Disciples Multiply

- a. Support the Mission Training Program (MTP) Coordinator to integrate, innovate and align the MTPs (SOAR, TREK, ACTION, Life on Mission, etc.) in your region.
- b. Orient churches towards the lost by:
 - i. Coaching and encouraging churches to reach their neighbors and to engage cross-culturally in their city.
 - ii. Helping our various ethnic churches engage with Multiply within their capacity
- c. Developing, coordinating, and communicating the integration of Multiply into the broader US vision and strategy with the USMB National Director and District Minister.

4. Shepherd the Regional Team

 Pastor and lead the Pacific District Mobilization office staff, MTP staff, as well as volunteers from churches who are involved in MTP events. b. Oversee the budgets that fall under Direct Reports (Mobilization Staff, MTP staff and volunteers, Multiply Pacific District office).

 - a. Diligently pursue healthy patterns of communication with other Multiply Missionaries, your US Director and the Multiply International office, including budgets, goals, strategic planning, etc.
 - b. Resolve conflicts arising between team members in a timely fashion, modeling biblical principles of interpersonal integrity, confession, grace, and forgiveness.
- 2. Encourage and grow the spiritual maturity of North American prayer and financial partners via regular communication and prayer for them.
 - a. Write regular (perhaps monthly) updates to supporters, encouraging their faith journey and spiritual development by sharing yours.
- 3. While carrying out these Responsibilities and Expectations, you are also expected to:
 - a. Model Multiply values as outlined and agreed upon in the Multiply Christian Foundations and Standards.
 - b. Promote the organization.
 - c. Honor lines of authority and accountability.
 - d. Communicate and share all relevant information with the US Mission Team Leader.
 - e. Disclose to the US Mission Team Leader any violations of your limitation of authority.
 - f. Maintain communication with your regional office.
