Assignment: Please copy the following paragraphs on your own paper for the ENTIRE CLASS PERIOD (from bell to bell). If you complete the assignment before the period ends, you must go back to the beginning and write it over again. In other words, you need to be working/writing the ENTIRE class period.

This Assignment is DUE TOMORROW at the beginning of the period with a **parent signature**. This in-class assignment takes place of an after school detention, so if it is incomplete or has no parent signature, you will have to serve another suspension the following class day and copy the entire assignment **twice** or be given alternate written assignments until the original assignment is returned with a parent/guardian signature.
