

The Multicenter Perioperative Outcomes Group (MPOG) is seeking interested faculty from an active MPOG member site to serve as **MPOG Pediatric Subcommittee Vice Chair** for a 2 year term.

The MPOG *quality improvement* mission: Improve patient outcomes by empowering perioperative teams to collaborate across sites, explore variation in practice and identify opportunities to advance the quality of care delivered. Informed by our complementary Research mission, we develop measures to assess performance, build tools to disseminate the best available evidence, and create dashboards to facilitate benchmarking.

In this role, faculty will participate in monthly web meetings led by the MPOG Pediatric Subcommittee Chair and program manager. Additionally, they will:

- 1. Work with the Pediatric Program Manager and Subcommittee Chair to determine the agenda and lead quarterly Pediatric Subcommittee meetings.
- 2. Provide feedback on QI project and pediatric measure proposals, prior to subcommittee review
- 3. Assist MPOG Pediatric Program Manager and Subcommittee Chair in maintaining pediatric measure specifications and managing the Measure Review schedule
- 4. Provide clinician perspectives to Pediatric Program Manager on the development of communication materials and tools (e.g. <u>QI Reporting Tool</u>, <u>MPOG DataDirect</u>)
- 5. Be able to devote approximately 2-4 hours per month to this role.

Qualifications:

- Medical doctorate degree (MD, DO, MBBS, MBChB, or equivalent) with ABA Board certification in Pediatric Anesthesiology or international equivalent.
- Faculty appointment at an active MPOG member site
- Experience/expertise in anesthesiology quality improvement
