8. **Tchaikovsky** – Symphony nr. 6, 1<sup>st</sup> movement (from m. 19 to m. 38, m. 50 to m. 54, m. 58 to m. 66)

9. **Strauss** – *Don Juan* (from beginning to m. 7, from 3 measures before **A** to 4 measures before **B**, from **C** to 5 measures after **C**)

10. **Mahler** – Symphony nr. 5, 3<sup>rd</sup> movement (from m. 39 to m. 46 and from m. 204 to m. 217)

11. **Mahler** – Symphony nr. 5, 5<sup>th</sup> movement (from m. 272 to m. 293)
