Sibling Transportation:

Closed Campus – Students are not permitted to leave the school grounds at any time during the school day. Students are required to be on school grounds, at all times, between morning arrival and evening departure.

Exceptions to closed campus –

- All 9th -12th grade students must have a signed Open Campus form on file at the office prior to the school year. The form must be signed by the students parent or guardian. If the student is driving a motor vehicle, all the conduct rules in the driving/parking section will be adhered to. Violation of these requirements will be cause for revocation of your Open Campus.
- 7th and 8th grade students will be required to have permission, in writing, from a parent for each day off-campus release is requested. The written permission must be delivered to office staff before 1st period.

Noon Tardies:

Due to the high number of tardies for students returning to class after lunch, the following policy prevails for the entire school year.

- i. During any quarter when a student reaches 2 tardies at the end of the lunch period that student will lose the privilege of Open Campus and will remain on campus the rest of the quarter. This also applies to Junior High students.
- ii. Not honoring the on-campus consequences will result in a minimum of two days out-of-school suspension.
