### Test Day Instructions for Families

- **At 8:00 am on test days, log into your google classroom to get a Test Session ID. Write it down.**
- **Log out of Rapid Identity**
- **Open the Secure Testing App \***

*This is located on the lower left corner of your screen. Click where it says “apps,”*



*or shows the “waffle” icon. Choose the app that says “Secure Test Browser”*

- **Enter Student FIRST name.\*\***
- **Enter Student SSID (This is the long number)**
- **Enter the TEST SESSION ID given by your teacher. CA-\_\_\_\_-\_\_\_\_**
- **Your teacher will then approve your request to join the session.** Students will be able to communicate with the teacher from that point on, for further instructions.

*\*Note: If the secure browser will not open, completely log out/sign out of everything else on your device, this will likely solve the problem.*

*\*\*Note: Some students will need to use both their first and middle names- check your login information below.*

## **Test Security for Parents with Students Testing Remotely**

*The CAASPP SBAC virtual sessions will be run by a trained test administrator who will work with your student to answer any questions. Once your student is actively logged in and able to communicate with the test administrator, the student is expected to work independently without direct observation outside of the supervision of the test administrator who the student will be able to see, hear and speak to. Any deviation from this risks invalidating test results, and jeopardizing future remote testing opportunities.*

*Please help us keep the test sessions in compliance with the requirements of secure test administration.*

***Please keep in mind these important points from The Test Security Affidavit that apply to families testing remotely.***

- I will not divulge the contents of the CAASPP achievement tests and corresponding test materials to any other person through verbal, written, or any other means of communication. This includes, but is not limited to, sharing or posting test content via the Internet or by email without the prior express written permission of the CDE.
- I will not copy or take a photo of any part of the achievement test(s) or corresponding test materials. This includes, but is not limited to, photocopying (including enlarging) and recording without the prior expressed written permission of the CDE.
- I will limit access to the achievement test(s) and corresponding test materials by test examinees to the actual testing periods when they are taking the test(s). I understand that only pupils who are testing and LEA staff participating in the test administration who have signed a CAASPP Test Security Affidavit may be in the room when and where an achievement test is being administered.
  - I will keep all assigned, generated, or created usernames, passwords, and logins secure and not divulge pupil personal information to anyone other than the pupil to whom the information pertains for the purpose of logging on to the test delivery system.
  - I will not allow anyone other than the assigned pupils to log into their assigned test. I may assist pupils with using their information to log into their assigned test.
  - I will not use a pupil's information to log in as a pupil or allow a pupil to log in using another pupil's information.
- I will not allow pupils to access electronic devices that allow them to access outside information, communicate with other pupils, or photograph or copy test content. This includes, but is not limited to, cell phones, personal digital assistants (PDAs), tablets, laptops, cameras, and electronic translation devices.
