Jen attended 2 sessions; trauma information and responses. Approx 60 people attended, only 2 BOE reps were there. Hands on Multi-Sensory. Keynote was about mild anxiety. <p>Principal Updates Budget and Staffing</p>		<p>Dr. Page</p>	<p>E-DCSD dual enrollment will no longer allowed in the school year 2022/2023 Next year enrollment as of today is 1,535, estimated was 1,540. Still expect to add foreign exchange students (usually 7).</p> <p>As of last Thursday, 200 teacher openings. Historically number would 50. 206 employees displaced. Usually ½ of displacements can fill openings. HRHS has zero displacements.</p> <p>HRHS will be hiring a science teacher for AP Physics. Currently, HRHS is 1 English down (expected and planned for), and will be hiring 1 other math teacher. ISS will be growing by 1 FTE teacher, as well as 1 FTE for SSN. Athletic director has decided to move to a school in another district, so a replacement will need to be hired.</p> <p>District is open with helping with emergency licensure to help with staffing issues if need be.</p> <p>\$73,000 spent out of this year's school budget for subs with 1 full quarter left to go, prior years have been \$60-65k in part due to increase of sub pay. Next year subs will be paid from District, not to come out of school's budget.</p> <p>Budget looks good. \$95k over for emergencies/extras.</p> <p>District will not approve seniors to come back for 2nd year of Cosmetology, as we had hoped they would allow. Hope for that to occur in future years.</p>
