

IT Status Update - 2014-09-16

- OWASP Wiki is not fully updated to the latest version of MediaWiki - 1.23.3
 - All MediaWiki extensions were reviewed and audited

 - 28 extensions updated to the latest, 15 extensions retired
 - Only OWASP Foundation Analytics account is being used now
- OWASP Wiki is now being CDN'ed by Akamai as of 2014-09-13
- Process for handling sub-domain requests
 - This needs to be documented
 - Chapters vs projects
 - Hosted vs DNS
- Should OWASP consider providing shared hosting to some set of projects or chapters
 - How to handle requests for sub-domains?
- I would like a budget for small IT purchases going forward with a cap of for any single expense
- Notes on Conference sites
 - Placid Slider needs updating on AppSec APAC site - license is \$8
 - Need to ping AppSec APAC 2014 team about archiving the site
 - Should we set a max life before conferences go static?
 - Placid Slider needs updating on AppSec USA site - license is \$8
 - Consider purchasing the paid version of WordFence
 - Should we offer a standard package for conference sites?
- I would like to move forward on a trial of osTicket SaaS for handling IT-related requests.
 - I would like to signup for single month to try out osTicket and, if the trial period goes well, move to a yearly contract. I will need a means of payment - an OWASP credit card is the easiest.
 - osTicket would allow longer running and interactive dialog when solving more complex IT issues. This is quite difficult with the Contact US and request are getting lost in my inbox. This would provide a single place for all pending IT issues/requests.
 - osTicket is currently \$16/user/month - even with a couple of IT support volunteers (Achim for example), the yearly cost is small e.g. 5 users = \$960/year
- Private Github account to host Ansible code to run our infrastructure
 - I've begun to Ansible-ize our infrastructure and administration tasks.
 - Can allow for limited sudo access for IT volunteers though Ansible playbook configuration
- Board should look at Vidyo
 - Google hangouts with no min caps on participation
 - Win/OS X/Linux clients
