Here is a personalized study guide that you can use to review for your unit test next week. I created a "to-do" list that will walk you through a process for studying that will hopefully be effective and efficient. Give it a try and see how you do!

1. Quizlet	Go through the unit vocabulary by reviewing the key terms. I suggest the flashcards, matching, and gravity game. Pay special attention to the terms that are most challenging
2. Kahoots:	Practice ALL of the kahoots--I sometimes copy and paste questions from the kahoot onto the test. I recommend taking each kahoot at least 2-3 times and writing down concepts that you need to review more → General Overview → City Models → New Urbanism and Gentrification
3. Review your Reading Notes	Go back and read through your Key Issues from each chapter--treat these as a study guide by reviewing the vocabulary and key questions. Focus especially on areas that you might have missed in the kahoots.
5. Quizlet Again	Go back to the quizlet that you started with to re-review the key terms. Understanding the vocabulary is the most direct way to doing well on the unit test for both the FRQ and the MC
