Music Education - Instrumental Music Education (K-12), BM

All music majors must complete a successful <u>audition</u> with voice or instrument and <u>apply</u> to the Music Education program.

Placement Exams for the Major:

 MAT 1010 will fulfill the math requirement for this major. You can register for MAT 1010 regardless of your SAT/ACT score and you do not need the Math Placement Test. Consult with your academic advisor if you want to consider a higher level math course for any reason.

If you have already been **accepted** into the <u>Hayes School of Music</u>, your 1st semester schedule will be built for you.

For all students who **intend** to major in Music but who have not yet successfully <u>auditioned</u>, here are recommended courses:

- 1. RC 1000 or UCO 1200 if there are seats available. If not, it's fine to take both classes in the spring semester.
- 2. Enroll in MUS 2618 (Intercultural Literacy (ICL/ FA)
- 3. Enroll in MAT 1010 (see Math Placement note above)
- 4. Enroll in a **Wellness Literacy** course --Suggested; MUS 2054 Alexander Technique, 2 of 3 hours completes this General Education requirement.
- 5. Enroll in 1 hr Ensemble: possibly MUS 1100 Marching Band, MUS 1104 Jazz Ensemble, MUS 1107 Small Ensembles, MUS 1109 Appalachian Chorale (no audition required), MUS 1111 ASU Glee Club, MUS 1110 Treble Choir or MUS 1108 University Singers, MUS 1117 Gospel Choir (no audition required)

Students who are not admitted to the Hayes School of Music should review the <u>Preliminary Information</u> <u>for Students Considering Music</u> document as well.

Having trouble registering?

- Review the Student Self-Service Guide for Registration instructions and videos.
- If the courses above are closed, add yourself to waitlists.
- Then add appropriate classes from page 2 of the 2025-2026 Checksheet until you have registered for 12-15 total hours.
- Use the Gen Ed Requirements in the Bulletin to look up Gen Ed course descriptions.
- Use this <u>Course Prefixes/Subjects list</u> to know which subject to choose in the Class Search in AppalNet.
- Rewatch the <u>Gen Ed video in PREP</u> to better understand the Categories and Designations components of Gen Ed.
 - All English Literary Studies: ENG xxxx (LS) designation courses have a prerequisite of R C 1000, First Year Writing (R C = Rhetoric & Composition.)
- BOONE CAMPUS students: Here is a <u>color-coded 2-page General Education checksheet</u> (updated 3x/day) that shows which Boone Campus Gen Ed classes have open seats.

Can't get into the classes above? Try these:

- MUS 1000 if you have not passed the <u>music theory placement test</u> (Elements of Music Theory, not required but may help prospective students prepare for program admission)
- PSY 2010 (Psychology of teaching) Humanity and its systems (not required, but relevant for education majors).
- Foundations of American Democracy course
- A Literary Studies (LS) Designation Course.
- A Social Science (SS) Designation Course.
- Science of your choosing (Exploring Science is encouraged by the School of Music). Must have math prerequisites. Review how to register linked courses (sciences include a lab).
 - PHY 1812 Acoustics and Harmonics (4) Fall only
 - PHY 1814 Sound and Recording (4) Spring only

*Note: Admitted Music students will be required to take MUS 2617 which have the (HS) designation you need.
