  - 2/9–2/20: Campus partner content editing phase #2
  - 2/23–2/27: NSTP makes final edits
  - 3/2/26: Final deadline for all content edits
- **How to Submit Your Edits by 1/20/26:**
  1. Locate your personalized department document link in the “Department Editing Doc” column on [Tab 2. Edit Submissions](#).
    - a. The editing documents have instructions about how to access content and provide edits.
  2. Once edits have been provided, update “Round 1 Edit Status” column”
    - a. “CP Reviewed, No Edits Needed” –No updates required
    - b. “Schedule Time with NSTP” – We'll reach out to collaborate
    - c. “CP Edits Complete” – Edits submitted
  3. NSTP will reach out with questions or to begin Phase 2 of edits
