



## **Business Requirements for 2026**

- Educators will participate in the iBb program between August 4-6, 2026, for either three or six hours each day (with a one-hour lunch, provided by you or on their own).
  
- Your business will have the opportunity to:
  - Show teachers which skills are vital to your business.
  - Market careers facing critical workplace shortages.
  - Influence the educational program.
  - Promote employment opportunities at your firm.
  - Achieve positive public relations via community outreach.
  
- Educators will receive a stipend and credit after the iBb experiences and the submission of the following items:
  - A visual slide presentation which will include an overview of the iBb experience and a description of program outcomes. The presentation will be shared with fellow interns, business mentors, and your school district via a Google folder. Interns are encouraged to share their presentations with colleagues as appropriate.
  - The slideshow presentation should include the following information:
    - Summary of business experience
    - Educational skill requirements of new hires
    - Salary ranges and benefits for entry-level positions
    - Host company's greatest asset
    - Host company's greatest challenge and how it is being addressed
    - Synthesis of skills that students are required to have to be successful in the workplace
    - How you will integrate your experience into your instruction next school year.
