

## Associate PI Scheme Champion - Role Description

### Aims of the role:

- To serve as a local source of information and expertise for the Associate PI Scheme.
- To promote the uptake of the Associate PI Scheme and encourage study teams to register their studies onto the scheme.
- To encourage potential trainees to register onto the scheme.
- To provide practical expertise to local staff regarding the registration requirements for new trials onto the Associate PI Scheme.
- To disseminate information about the scheme among staff members.
- To possess knowledge about the expectations for health and care professionals participating in the scheme and aid in discussions with staff.
- To report any locally (or nationally) paused/suspended studies to the Associate PI Scheme Team.

### Remit of the Role:

- We anticipate the Champion to be someone with a robust comprehension of the Associate PI Scheme and research delivery. However, the Champion's role is not expected to be labour-intensive. The primary objective is to promote the Associate PI Scheme within the managing organisation and create awareness of the Scheme for dissemination and uptake. Dissemination efforts may include informal discussions with colleagues and presentations at local meetings.
