The COVID-19 relief packages recently passed by the United States Congress contain numerous benefits for families financially impacted by the pandemic. One of the benefits is to help families who have children who are eligible for free or reduced priced school meals called the Pandemic-EBT (P-EBT) program. The benefit comes on an Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card, which is like a debit card. The P-EBT can be used to purchase food items. By completing the Free and Reduced Priced application, the information will help determine if your students are eligible for the P-EBT program. Please note that completing the application will not impact your student's ability to continue to receive free meals through June 2021.

If you believe your school-aged child(ren) may qualify for free or reduced-price meals this school year and have not yet submitted the application for free or reduced-price meals to the school, we encourage you to do so as soon as possible.
