Some basic information about being a Member of the Club.

Accepted Membership Applicants will receive a "photo identity" membership card. This card must be carried with you at any time you are fishing on the pier. You may be asked to show your card by another club member or a pier official. Failure to show it when requested will result in you being asked to leave the pier immediately. You will also be informed of the access code to use the electronic gate at the entrance to the pier. **This code must not be passed to any other person.** Do not allow anyone else to use the gate when you arrive or leave unless they have a membership card.

Should you bring any other person onto the pier who is not a club member, your membership will be revoked immediately and there will be no refund of any fees. This will result in a lifetime ban.

Some Competitions use only 1 rod and 3 hooks.

A Pennel Rig counts as 2 hooks.

Fishing the pier head is generally allowed when the pier is closed to the public.

There are exceptions and we will do our best to inform members of these.

You must never put bait of any type on the seats.

Always use a bait board and always clean your area before you leave. You must take all fishing related waste away with you, so bring a bin bag and don't dispose of any waste in the pier bins either. The pier are very strict about this.

We hold 2 competitions a month (1 Sunday and 1 Wednesday).

We also have some competitions at Blue Anchor.

There is a small charge for these comps, but they are primarily social gatherings and a great way to meet other members. There is of course a chance to win monthly and annual trophies. Competitions are pegged from the pier head towards the entrance and take priority over pleasure fishing.

The Pier is a 'No Smoking Zone. Please respect this.

There are no toilet facilities when the pier is closed. The nearest public 24hr toilets are situated near the 'Little Harp' Public House. (20p Charge).

Junior Members: Children up to the age of 18years. (must be accompanied by a full member when fishing)

Social Membership: This allows you to bring the Social Member onto the pier when you are fishing. They are not allowed to fish. They must always be accompanied by a Full Member. It does not allow them onto the pier at any other time.

Most of all, enjoy your fishing and we hope you really become a 'Club Member'.
