Precautions and Warnings

- 1. **Alcohol:** Limit alcohol intake as it may increase the risk of side effects like dizziness and low blood pressure.
- 2. **Driving or Operating Machinery:** Apomorphine may cause drowsiness or dizziness. Avoid activities requiring alertness if affected.
- 3. **Pre-existing Conditions:** Inform your doctor if you have any heart conditions, low blood pressure, liver or kidney disease, or a history of priapism.
- 4. Drug Interactions:
 - Do not combine with nitrates or other medications that lower blood pressure.
 - Avoid combining with other PDE5 inhibitors or medications affecting dopamine levels without medical advice.

When to Call Your Doctor

Contact your healthcare provider if you:

- Experience severe side effects or allergic reactions (rash, itching, swelling).
- Have persistent side effects interfering with daily life.
- Notice that the medication is not working as expected.

Storage

- Store at room temperature (20-25°C or 68-77°F).
- Keep away from moisture, heat, and direct sunlight.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.

Additional Tips for Success

- Engage in foreplay to maximize the medication's effects.
- Maintain a healthy lifestyle, including regular exercise, balanced nutrition, and stress management, to improve overall erectile function.
