Title: The Penguin Review: A Magazine for History & Politics

Abstract:

Our group oral presentation will describe how we created The Penguin Review: A Magazine for History and Politics through a year-long History & Politics internship at Dominican University of California. We will show how our student-led magazine gives students a voice, connects historical, political, and cultural inquiry to civic affairs, and creates a space for thoughtful student work. We will describe how we built the magazine from the ground up—defining its purpose, selecting submissions, editing student work, and promoting it across campus—while reflecting on what we learned about research, collaboration, revision, outreach, and project management. We will also consider the value of creating a student-led publication for readers beyond the classroom, what we learned from the experience, and how we hope to pass the magazine on to future student editors.
