### **1A - Steve**

Football - Keep 6-man and 8-man is important. Discussed 9-man, not a great desire, but understand that it may need to go 9-man.

Schedule/SOP Integrity - Always a problem at 1A. New ADs, integrity, loss of communication with new ADs coming in.

Classification: Please don't leave 1A alone. We need some fixes, but need help figuring it out. 92% in favor of splitting play-offs to 1A or 1B. Geographical leagues, then different play-offs.

State championships: Possible 1A/1B split. Wheel championship where you have to match up with a different league each year. We want it strongly addressed, but it hasn't gotten past the discussion stage.

Full time enrollment: Can see benefits of yes or no

Regional Hardship: Would rather have it classification oriented

Point Differential: 35 point is good

Shot Clock: Majority not in favor of shot clock.

Full time enrollment: Lower it or get rid of it

Co-op: Have a school run a JV schedule

Regional Hardship: No.

#### **6A - Russ Bolin**

Football: They need to look at everything. 6, 8, 9, & 11. Look at it every year or every two years.

SOP/Schedule Integrity: We do a good job, but we need to update new ADs on standards. Need to keep integrity of schedules set.

Classification: We need feedback. We'd like a 5 classification draft with the 3-Rivers intact. Need leagues with enough schools to fill a schedule.

State Championships: 1-16 is a bracket. 17-32 is a bracket. We have to pay the workers. Get rid of power rankings. League champs automatically get to host a play-off game

Co-op: Yes for 6A to 6A, but no for others co-oping with 6A.

Full time enrollment:
